Thank you for your interest in our College and Career Bound Academy programs at the TGR Learning Lab! This application includes information about our summer program and the application process. Description: The College and Career Bound Academy is for students who are interested in hands-on, interactive, college and career-focused experiences. Programs are open to students who will be entering the 9th-12th grade in the 2024-2025 academic school year.

ID Badge: One ID badge will be made for each student accepted into the summer program. This ID badge will be used throughout the summer program from Monday, June 10 to Thursday, August 1. To replace a lost or misplaced ID badge there will be a \$5 fee. All students must wear their ID badge after their first day to enter the TGR Learning Lab.

Application Process: There are three steps in the application process. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. If the classes selected are full, students will be contacted to be added to a waitlist. There are a limited number of spaces per class; early application submissions are encouraged. Please follow all directions and use the checklist below to complete each step:

- Step 1: Select a program.
- Step 2: Complete the registration form.
- Step 3: Submit the application, grade verification and payment by mail or drop it off at the TGR Learning Lab.

Grade Verification: A copy of student applicants' most recent report card is required to verify their current grade level. Applications will not be processed without a copy of each applicant's most recent report card.

Cancellation Policy: Students who wish to cancel their participation must inform the TGR Learning Lab in writing at least 15 days before the start of class to receive a refund. No refunds will be granted after this time. Cancellations will only be accepted in person or through email or fax messages.

Session Dates: June 10-21, 2024

Current high school juniors and rising seniors

Immerse yourself in a two-week in-person academy with an emphasis on the college admissions and financial aid processes. Focusing on four-year universities, it will include a variety of informative and interactive workshops such as:

- Writing a personal statement (PIQs and more).
- Creating a college list.
- Completing the FAFSA and CSS Profile.
- Preparing for the SAT.
- Building leadership and career development featuring Disney.
- Visiting a college campus.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be entering the 12th grade in fall 2024.
- Must demonstrate college prep curriculum.
- Must be committed to attending the entire two-week academy over the summer. Students will be dropped from the program with more than one absence.

Timeframe: During the **summer**, classes are held Monday - Friday from 9 am to 12 p.m.* There will also be a Disneyland trip for **Leadership the Disney Way** workshop and a college excursion. The dates have not been set yet; the time of class those days will be 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. There will be no class on Wednesday, June 19. *Times subject to change

Fee: The cost is \$10 and only cash will be accepted. Payment is due when the application is submitted.

Session Dates: June 24-26

Current high school sophomores and rising high school juniors

- Must be committed to attending the entire three-day academy during the summer.

Timeframe: During the **summer**, classes are held Monday - Friday from 9 am to 12 p.m.* On the final day there will be a college visit excursion; the time of class this day will be 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Fee: The cost is \$5 and only cash will be accepted. Payment is due when the application is submitted.

Session Dates: July 8-10

Current 8th & 9th Graders – Rising High School Freshmen and Sophomores

Immerse yourself in a three-day in-person college and career readiness program with your peers. The session will focus on essential skills and proper etiquette for a successful high school career through informative and interactive workshops on a variety of topics including:

Eligibility Requirements:

Timeframe: During the summer, classes are held Monday - Friday from 9 am to 12 p.m.* On the final day there will be a career industry excursion; the time of class this day will be 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Fee: The cost is \$5 and only cash will be accepted. Payment is due when the application is submitted.

For all College and Career Bound Academy programs, there will be follow-up throughout the school year; fall 2024 through spring 2025. During the **academic year**, workshops and open advising will be held after school on topics such as academic planning, writing support, college, scholarship and financial aid applications support, etc.
