Thank you for your interest in our College and Career Bound Academy programs at the TGR Learning Lab! **Description:** The College and Career Bound Academy is for students who are interested in hands-on, interactive, college and career-focused experiences. Programs are open to students who will be entering the 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade in the 2024-2025 academic school year.

**ID Badge:** One ID badge will be made for each student accepted into the summer program. This ID badge will be used throughout the summer program from Monday, June 10 to Thursday, August 1. To replace a lost or misplaced ID badge there will be a \$5 fee. All students must wear their ID badge after their first day to enter the TGR Learning Lab.

**Application Process:** There are three steps in the application process. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. If the classes selected are full, students will be contacted to be added to a waitlist. There are a limited number of spaces per class; early application submissions are encouraged. Please follow all directions and use the checklist below to complete each step:

- o Step 1: Select a program.
- o Step 2: Complete the registration form.
- Step 3: Submit the application, grade verification and payment by mail or drop it off at the TGR Learning Lab.

**Grade Verification:** A copy of student applicants' most recent report card is required to verify their current grade level. Applications will not be processed without a copy of each applicant's most recent report card.

**Cancellation Policy:** Students who wish to cancel their participation must inform the TGR Learning Lab in writing at least 15 days before the start of class to receive a refund. No refunds will be granted after this time. Cancellations will only be accepted in person or through email or fax messages.

**Timeframe:** During the **summer**, classes are held Monday - Friday from 9 am to 12 p.m.\* There will also be a Disneyland trip for **Leadership the Disney Way** workshop and a college excursion. The dates have not been set yet; the time of class those days will be 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. There will be no class on Wednesday, June 19. \*Times subject to change

**Fee:** The cost is \$10 and only cash will be accepted. Payment is due when the application is submitted.

For all College and Career Bound Academy programs, there will be follow-up throughout the school year; fall 2024 through spring 2025. During the **academic year**, workshops and open advising will be held after school on topics such as academic planning, writing support, college, scholarship and financial aid applications support, etc.
