POSITION SUMMARY:

The Youth Golf Coach is a part-time position responsible for supporting TGR Learning Lab (TGR LL) golf department staff in delivering golf instruction to students in grades 5-12. The Youth Golf Coach is instrumental in introducing the game of golf to students, teaching golf fundamentals, and creating a fun and positive environment for students to learn.

The position is seasonal and needed from June 24 – August 1, 2024. The position requires a flexible schedule with the ability to work 20 hours per week Monday – Thursday, and 4-6 hours on Saturdays.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Maintains and models high standards of behavior and performance while working with youth ages 5 – 18;
- Implements innovative TGR Learning Lab golf curricula;
- Leads small and large group golf instruction for students in grades 5- 12 weekly during summer programs and weekend golf clinics;
- Ability to share the load of instructing 24 students with colleagues
- Maintains a safe, engaging learning environment for youth;
- Sets up and breaks down equipment for each lesson/clinic;
- Follows a schedule of events related to each lesson/clinic;
- Supports and assists Golf Department staff as assigned;
- Communicates directly with Golf Department staff on a regular basis;
- Other golf-related duties as assigned;

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE & SKILLS REQUIRED:

- Prior golf experience working with junior instruction and coaching;
- Demonstrates strong golf knowledge and skills regarding golf techniques, rules, and etiquette;



- Must be able to use a golf club and demonstrate golf skills while teaching golf curricula;
- Willing to be part of an innovative movement of the development of underserved youth using golf as a vehicle to inspire, motivate and mentor youth to find a passion;
- Ability to integrate technology to implement in golf lessons and activities;
- Strong interpersonal, presentation, organizational and verbal/written communication skills;
- Promotes collaborative planning and innovative thinking;
- Ability to work as a team and in a fast-paced environment;
- Willingness to learn and instruct drills and other practice curriculum;
- Ability to work 18 hours a week June 24-July 27, Monday through Thursday; and 4 hours on Saturdays;
