# Move the Can

Using a string, you must move an unopened can across the floor, keeping it upright, as far as you can. However, the string may not touch the can!



### **Reflection Questions:**

What aspects of your design worked well?

What aspects of your design did not work well?



#### Redesign Challenge:

You must attach the string to the top of the can and pull on it to move the can, keeping it upright. The string must stay parallel to the ground. How would you redesign your can-transporter to meet this challenge?

  - About the problems? About yourself?
- What were some of the difficulties of the Design Challenges?
  - What made them difficult?
