 Plan, manage, and facilitate training and coaching for educators, emphasizing inquiry-based learning, student skill-building, and career connections.



- Coordinate the design of curriculum and materials for existing and new professional learning activities.
- Oversee professional learning activities in Orange and Los Angeles Counties and support professional learning activities in Philadelphia.
- Provide leadership and guidance to promote high expectations and standards for quality teaching and learning for all.
- Provide departmental leadership that promotes collaborative planning, innovative thinking and exemplary programs and services.
- Supervise and evaluate the performance of assigned personnel.
- Share in building community, partner, and national relationships to engage partners and educators in professional learning opportunities.
- Network with Orange and Los Angeles County education communities and build professional relationships with members of the industry in the area.
- Develop and maintain on-boarding trainings and ongoing development for programs staff, including the implementation of a new coaching model.
