Description: The College and Career Bound Academy is for students who are interested in hands-on, interactive, college and career-focused experiences. Programs are open to students who will be entering the 9th-12th grade in the 2025-2026 academic school year.

ID Badge: One ID badge will be made for each student accepted into the summer program. This ID badge will be used throughout the duration of the summer program from June 23 to July 31. To replace a lost or misplaced ID badge there will be a \$5 charge. All students must wear their ID badge after their first day of the summer program to have safe and secure access into the building.

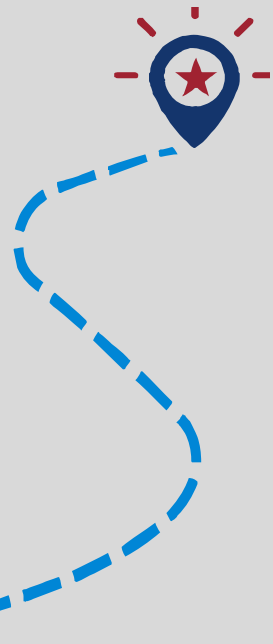
Application Process: There are three steps in the application process. Classes are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. If the classes selected are full, students will be contacted to be added to a waitlist. There are a limited number of spaces per class; early application submissions are encouraged. Please follow all directions and use the checklist below to complete each step:

- Step 1: Select a class.
- Step 2: Complete the registration form.
- Step 3: Submit the application, grade verification and payment by mail or drop it off at the TGR Learning Lab.

Grade Verification: A copy of student applicants' most recent report card is required to verify their current grade level. Applications will not be processed without a copy of each applicant's most recent report card.

Cancellation Policy: Students who wish to cancel their participation must inform the TGR Learning Lab in writing at least 15 days before the start of class to receive a refund. No refunds will be granted after this time. Cancellations will only be accepted in person or through email or fax messages.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be entering the 12th grade in fall 2025.
- Must demonstrate college prep curriculum.
- Must be committed to attending the entire two-week academy over the summer. Students will be dropped from the program with more than one absence.

Timeframe: During the **summer**, classes are held Monday - Friday from 9 am to 12 p.m.* There will be a college visit excursion during the session; the time of class this day will be 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. **Times subject to change*

Fee: The cost is \$10 and only cash will be accepted. Payment is due when the application is submitted.
