- Maintains and models high standards of behavior and performance while working with youth;
- Implements innovative TGR Learning Lab golf curricula;
- Leads small and large group golf instruction during our summer programs and weekend golf clinics;
- Ability to share the load of instructing up to 24 students;
- Maintains a safe, engaging learning environment for youth;
- Sets up and breaks down equipment for each lesson/clinic;
- Follows a schedule of events related to each lesson/clinic;
- Communicates directly with Cobbs Creek Golf Management and Programs staff on a regular basis;
- Other golf-related duties as assigned.
