Historically, the Foundation has worked with students starting in 5th grade to provide STEM-based learning and career exploration experiences to broaden their horizons about post-secondary options. To further expand and enhance impact on students throughout their educational journey, the Foundation is developing new programming for high school students that utilize immersive, real-world learning opportunities to better prepare them for the workforce and to become agents of change within their communities. The Career Connected Learning Program sits at the intersection of K-12, industry partnerships and out-of-school learning as a cross-sector model to connect students learning experiences through pathways.

JOB SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Director of Career Connected Learning Programs, the Career Connected Learning Advisor (Advisor) is responsible for leading student engagement teams at local high schools and providing post-secondary guidance to high school students at the TGR Learning Lab. A successful Advisor will have a deep belief in the potential of all students to realize their goals and will create strong relationships with students to better prepare them for post-secondary opportunities.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Student Management & Mentorship

- Case manage and support a cohort of high school students to create well-informed post-secondary plans aligned with their passions, strengths, and career aspirations.
- Hold weekly student engagement team meetings on school campuses and at the TGR Learning Lab and mentor student engagement teams to plan, conduct outreach, and execute community events and projects such as health fairs, eSports summits, and student showcases.
- Help students navigate out-of-school and extra-curricular activities to build a portfolio of learning experiences.



- Connect students with job readiness experiences, including internships, pre-apprenticeships, work-based learning programs, job shadowing opportunities, and industry projects.
- Support students with identifying and applying for enrichment programs, dual enrollment opportunities, and industry certifications that enhance their post-secondary readiness.
- Provide individualized coaching and mentorship to help students navigate barriers to their post-secondary goals, including financial literacy education and mental wellness resources.

Curriculum & Instruction

- Develop and deliver workshops on career exploration, interview preparation, resume building, and professional networking skills.
- Facilitate learning activities such as Learning Lab studios that advance students' self-discovery and self-advocacy
- Host career speakers and panels on school campuses and at the TGR Learning Lab, ensuring students have exposure to a wide range of career pathways and industry professionals.
- Facilitate evening and weekend programming for student cohorts, providing consistent mentorship and access to career-connected learning experiences beyond the traditional school day.
- Coordinate and lead Career Connected Learning field trips during school hours, offering students immersive exposure to real-world work environments and industry practices.

Assessment and Feedback

- Assist with tracking and evaluating student engagement in post-secondary planning activities, ensuring continuous improvement of support services.
- Collect, analyze, and report on student attendance, participation, and program outcomes to measure impact and inform program development.

Collaboration & Engagement

- Collaborate with school staff, community organizations, and industry partners to create pathways that bridge the gap between education and employment.
- Build and maintain relationships and communication with co-workers, students, families, volunteers and organizations.
