JOB SUMMARY:

Learning Support Staff will facilitate STEAM-related activities and workshops and provide homework support for students in grades 7-12. This position will be responsible for facilitating enrichment club activities as well as assisting and monitoring students who are working on homework and school-related projects. In addition, this position requires one to work closely with the instructional team on all activities that include or impact student programs.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

Curriculum & Instruction

- Facilitate 1–2 enrichment clubs per session with guidance from Learning Facilitators.
- Monitor and assist students during after-school and Academic Support times.
- Facilitate occasional Saturday workshops.
- Support special events (set-up/clean-up, supervision, activity facilitation).
- Assist Learning Facilitators during program hours as needed.
- Create an inclusive, supportive environment that promotes curiosity and exploration.

Assessment & Feedback

- Support data collection, including attendance and survey administration.

Collaboration & Engagement

- Collaborate with Learning Facilitators to deliver STEAM enrichment activities.
- Work with the team to provide individual and group homework support.
- Assist with student supervision, arrival/dismissal, and front desk duties as needed.
- Build positive relationships with students, families, and the Learning Lab community.



- Participate in professional development to stay current with STEAM education practices.
- Engage in coaching and classroom observations for continuous improvement.
- Assist with student recruitment at schools and community events.
- Maintain a safe, organized, and welcoming learning environment.

Mentorship & Student Support

- Serve as a mentor and role model, promoting a growth mindset and college/career readiness.
- Provide Learning Facilitators with regular updates on classroom activities and student progress.
- Foster a culture of high expectations that empowers students to succeed.
